Judith Sloan is an award-winning actress/audio artist/radio producer, human rights activist and educator whose work bridges the divide between expressive and documentary forms, combining humor, pathos and a love of the absurd. Her multi-character performances explore love, loss and the search for belonging. She'll be performing excerpts from her plays about working with immigrant youth, including *Yo Miss!* and *Crossing the BLVD*, and her play-in-progress, *It CAN Happen Here*. She is joined by singer **Emily Wexler** and pianist **Dominic Frigo**. Sloan will also be joined by two authors: Long-time collaborator and life partner, author/artist/performer **Warren Lehrer** will present excerpts from his books, including *Five Oceans in a Teaspoon* and *Trace: A Surveilled Novel*; and author/playwright Alvin Eng will read from his memoir, *Our Laundry, Our Town: My Chinese American Life from Flushing to the Downtown Stage and Beyond*.
